

**TOWN OF CARLYLE
BYLAW NO. 2012-15**

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CARLYLE TO AMEND BYLAW 2903, A BYLAW
TO REGULATE THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE COUNCIL AND COMMITTEES OF
THE COUNCIL**

The Council of the Town of Carlyle, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Bylaw 2903, Section 29 – Standing Committees of Council – is repealed and replaced with the following:

- **Protection and Public Safety** – which deals with matters of policing, fire protection, emergency measures operations and animal control.
- **Sanitation** – which deals with landfill operations, waste collection, untidy and unsightly property.
- **Public Works and Utilities** – which deals with matters of transportation equipment, streets, sidewalks, street lighting, trees, water and sewer, and snow removal.
- **Property** – which deals with the sale of town property, development of town property, public spaces, parks and zoning.
- **Finance and Human Resources** – which deals with matters of assessment, budget, mill rates, investments, loans, and employee relations.

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final reading thereof.
