**A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 2820, THE TRAFFIC BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF
CARLYLE**

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the public interest to amend the Traffic Bylaw

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Carlyle, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enact as follows:

1. That Bylaw No. 2820 be amended in the manner hereinafter set forth.
 - a. Section 4. n) 1) is hereby amended to read:
It shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on any highway except on Main Street from Railway Avenue to Coteau Avenue, solely for the purpose of leaving the municipality by the most direct route or returning to a residence by the most direct route.
 - b. Section 4. n) 4) is hereby deleted.
 - c. Section 4. o) 1) is hereby amended to read:
It shall be lawful to operate an all terrain vehicle between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on any highway except on Main Street from Railway Avenue to Coteau Avenue, solely for the purpose of leaving the municipality by the most direct route or returning to a residence by the most direct route.
 - d. Section 4.o) 3) is hereby deleted.
 - e. Section 7. e. is hereby amended to read:
Any person who commits a breach of any of the provisions of Section 4(f), (j) and (m) of this Bylaw shall be liable to a penalty of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$250.00.
2. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of the third and final reading thereof.
