BYLAW NO. 2022-02

**A BYLAW TO SET FEES FOR THE COLLECTION OF WASTE MATERIAL WITHIN THE
TOWN OF CARLYLE**

The Council of the Town of Carlyle, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Waste Management Fees Bylaw.

Definitions:

2. For the purpose of this Bylaw, the expression “municipality” shall mean the Town of Carlyle.

General Regulations:

3. The municipality shall set fees for the pickup of waste material and recycling material within the municipality.
4. The fees mentioned in section 2 of this bylaw shall be known as waste management fees.
5. Council of the Town of Carlyle shall review the waste management fees annually, and shall amend the waste management fees from time to time as needed.

6. The waste management fees shall be set as follows:

RESIDENTIAL:

COMMERCIAL:

7. All residential properties shall be provided with one residential garbage bin and one single stream recycling bin.
8. Residential properties requiring additional garbage bins or recycling bins shall be billed accordingly.
9. Waste collection will occur weekly; recycling collection will occur bi-weekly.
10. The waste management fee shall be billed quarterly on the water and sewer utility billing and is due when rendered. A penalty of 2% per month will be charged on any unpaid amounts on the 1st day of the month following the billing month.

11. In the case of commercial pickup, businesses may individually choose to opt out of the waste program provided by the Town, either garbage or both garbage and recycle, on the condition that the waste is picked up on a regular basis and hauled to a certified landfill outside of the Town of Carlyle.

12. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final reading thereof.

Repeal:

13. Bylaws 2014-07 and 2015-01 are hereby repealed.
